

Town of Woodruff Comprehensive Planning Commission

Minutes of Regular Meeting
December 10, 2009

Present: Planning Commission members Sarah Kemp, Chair, Joan Seramur, Judy Allen, Pat Bickner, secretary; Oneida County Supervisor Larry Greschner; and Leah Gernetzke, Lakeland Times reporter. Not present: Betty Henry

Meeting was called to order at 6:40 p.m.

Approval of Minutes. J. Allen moved to approve Nov. 3 regular meeting minutes, J. Seramur seconded, motion carried. J. Seramur moved to approve Nov. 30 special meeting minutes with corrections, J. Allen seconded, minutes approved.

Mr. Greschner provided copies of Woodboro Comprehensive Land Use Plan survey as a possible model or starting point for a similar Woodruff survey. Discussion followed as to whether it would be feasible in terms of time and resources. Greschner stated that conducting a survey would not delay the county's progress on their comprehensive plan, and he believes that an extension of the comprehensive plan deadline is possible and would need to be granted by the state legislature. Commission members present consented to pursue the option of conducting a survey of the town's residents regarding the land use plan.

Discussion of Chapters 3, 4, and 6 (Housing, Utilities and Comm. Facilities, and Economic Development, respectively). After discussion of Housing, the chair decided to table discussion of the other chapters.

P. Bickner motioned to adjourn; J. Seramur seconded; motion carried and meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
