RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Public Service (WPS) has cited the need to improve and reinforce its electricity distribution system to the Lakeland community due to increased demand; and

WHEREAS, American Transmission Company (ATC) has put forward a proposed route for a new transmission line as well as an alternate route; and


WHEREAS, ATC has held numerous open houses to present the proposed route (yellow), an alternate portion to the proposed route (blue) and the alternative route (green) and to receive public input on both; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Woodruff believes reliable energy production and transmission is an essential ingredient for economic growth, business prosperity, and residential comfort in the Lakeland community; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Woodruff believes that the community is better served by the proposed route with the alternate (blue) portion and that it makes a better fit for the community as well as less disruptive option than the other two routes; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Woodruff strongly supports the proposed route with the alternate portion (blue) route and strongly prefers the proposed route over the original proposed route (yellow) and the alternate (green) route.
